Top Parish is a fun event for young people aged 10-18 (but we're flexible). Up to 200+ youth gather from parishes all over the Waiapu Diocese.

Top Parish Games are played in teams of up to 6 people. They require ingenuity, co-operation, good humour and a keen sense of fair play. The competition is run at 2 levels:

Junior—5 out of 6 team members must be Year 9 and under

Open—any combination of ages (10-18)

A parish may enter one or more teams in either or both sections. Every team must be accompanied by an adult supervisor.

The teams with the

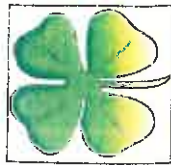
most points on the day

Our weekend ends with worship at St Lukes Rotorua. Youth groups are invited to take part in the service. Tell us what your group would like to contribute.

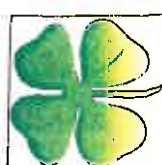
