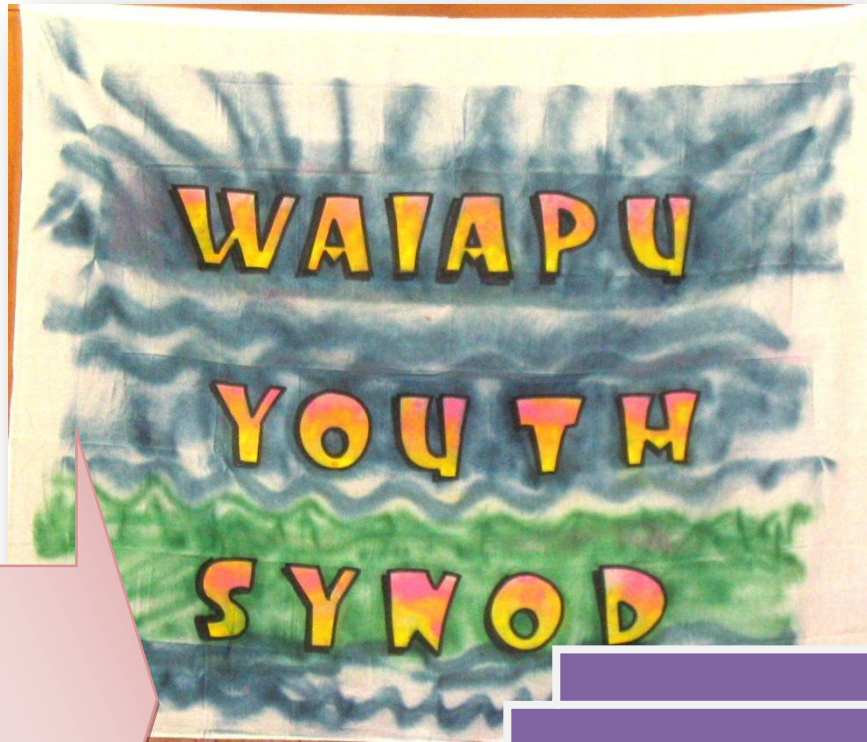


Waiapu Diocese Youth Synod September 17-19 Gisborne



Why Come to Youth Synod???

Youth Synod is an opportunity for young people involved in the Anglican Church to have their say. Youth (from 14-25 yrs) gather from all around the Diocese of Waiapu (that's Hawkes Bay, Bay of Plenty and Eastland) representing their churches and the young people in them. Youth Synod reps are usually part of the Regional Youth Councils, or can become members.

Transport All Parishes send Clergy and Synod Reps to Diocesan Synod, so ask them to save a seat for you

Who Can Come? The Diocese will subsidise 2 Youth Representatives (14-25yrs) from each Parish, costing them only \$40 each. If more than 2 youth from that Parish wish to attend they or their Parish need to pay the reduced price of \$60. Check with your Vicar or Youth Leader about who is eligible for subsidies.
